#### Holy Living

George Sweeting wrote, "When a person dies, often someone will ask, 'How much was he worth?' followed by an answer in dollars and cents. However, that's false. In reality, I am worth no more than the measure of growth in becoming like Jesus. Even though salvation is awesome, it is just the beginning of God's plan for us." When Jesus called to the twelve disciples, He simply said, "Follow Me." "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." Immediately they followed Jesus (Matthew 4:19-20). It was the same in the gospel of John; after Jesus called them, they followed Him (John 1:37, 43).

Continuing the Christian life means to follow Jesus day after day. It means to be increasingly conformed to the likeness of Jesus (Romans 8:29). Continuing to grow in the Christian life also means to be holy. The apostle Paul charged the believers in the Greek city of Corinth, "Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ" (1 Corinthians 11:1). It is important for each of us to ask, "Am I following Jesus?" Am I more interested in the things of God today than I was last year? There is a major delusion among Christians that only a select few are called to live Christlike lives. To the contrary, Ephesians 1:4 calls all believers to live "holy and blameless before Him."

The world in which we live calls us to live for self, gratification, and fame, but God calls us to live a holy life through Christ. Paul reminded the followers of Jesus in the city of Ephesus that they were chosen by God "before the foundation of the world" for this number one purpose of being holy (Ephesians 1:4). So what is holiness? Holiness is the joyful experience of God's character rubbing off on my character, by the faithful work of the Holy Spirit. Charles Colson said, "Holiness is not the private preserve of an elite corps of martyrs, mystics and Nobel Prize winners." To the contrary, holiness is everyday living for everyday people, under the leadership of the Holy Spirit.
