August Canal Trip – We have planned a trip to Augusta for Saturday, June 1st. We plan to leave at 7am. There are a couple of adventure options for the day. For those interested, you can choose to kayak down the Augusta Canal. The route is just over 5 miles long and takes about 2 hours. This is a perfect trip for beginner kayakers as there are no rapids, just a nice float trip with the river's current. You can rent a tandem (\$45) or single kayak (\$35) and will be shuttled back and forth. If 5 or more people sign up to kayak, you'll save \$5 per rental. For those who are not interested in kayaking, you can do a self-guided tour around the historic Savannah Rapids Park, complete with a playground, Visitor's Center and trails to explore. We plan to have a picnic lunch at the park before heading to The Augusta Canal Discovery Center.
